Out of Control: Driver Mistakes

The following are examples of mistakes that drivers may make that can potentially result in an accident.

- While driving down an entrance ramp, a tractor-trailer driver hit a patch of ice and lost control.
- A tractor-trailer driver swerved to avoid hitting a slow moving car. It ran off the road and through a guardrail.

Staying in Control: Severe Weather

State Farm Insurance suggests using extra caution during ice and snow:

- Slowing down and avoiding sudden changes in movement or direction
